Shrimp Mold Dip

Yes, the "mold" part doesn't sound good and it might not look very appetizing but it's a delicious appetizer my Aunt Nancy always made at holiday parties. My uncle and I would sit in front of it for most of the part and nibble away at it with crackers.

- 1 (10.75 oz.) can condensed tomato soup
- 1 ½ Tablespoons unflavored gelatin
- 2 small cans shrimp, drained
- 3-3 oz. pkg. cream cheese
- 1 cup mayo
- ¾ cup celery
- ¾ cup chopped green onion
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Dissolve gelatin in ¼ cup cold water. In double boiler bring soup to a boil. Dissolve cream cheese in soup and then add gelatin. Set aside until cool and add remaining ingredients. Put into a greased ring mold. Serve with crackers.
